WHEN: Saturday: December 7th 6:40 PM (parade starts at 7:00 PM)

WHERE: Parade participants will line up on York Street. (Do NOT drop dancers off at the studio.) We will not know our exact location in the line-up until the evening of the parade upon check-in. Simply look for the large, black-enclosed Dance Xplosion trailer. Volunteers will be available to guide you.

WHAT TO BRING: Extra warm clothing, your Dance Xplosion Jacket/T-shirt or sweatshirt (if you have one) worn over your warm clothing, a Santa hat, and your nutcracker craft from float building! If you weren't able to make a craft at float building, we have extras!

WHO: All DX Dancers!! An adult must accompany dancers 8 yrs and younger. All parents are welcome to join us.

Dancers can be picked up at the end of the parade route by Marble Memorial United Methodist Church across from the post office. All dancers need to be picked up directly following the parade and will not be brought back to the studio for pick up.
